This landmark event will feature invited lectures and round tables to review twenty years of research and explore future perspectives, all within a festive atmosphere to commemorate two decades of exchange within the TOTh community.

Don't miss the opportunity to submit your work to this landmark conference bringing together the foremost experts in the field. Selected papers will be published in a special volume of the Terminologica series.

Created in 2007, the TOTh community draws together researchers, teachers, trainers, practitioners, users and industrialists whose interests concern **Terminology** and, in a more general way, the links between language and knowledge in the context of our discipline, taking into account conceptual and technological advances in disciplines such as **Artificial Intelligence**.

TOTh is open to all streams of thought and sets out to provide a forum of exchange and sharing where problems are presented along with solutions and feedback from experience, on both the theoretic and the applied planes, as well as new tendencies and perspectives in the disciplines associated with Terminology (translation, lexicography, knowledge engineering, the information sciences ...).

The TOTh international community comprises more than 20 different nationalities and the most prominent personalities in the domain. The official languages are English and French. The annual events that TOTh organizes include a **Conference**, a **Training session**, and a **Workshop**.

Under the patronage of an international scientific committee, the TOTh Conferences cover an extensive field of studies and research concerning terminology and/or ontology. The opening talk, given by a renowned personality within his/her domain, aims to open new disciplinary fields that can relate to those from TOTh.

Scheduled every year at the University of Savoie (France) on two days in early June, the TOTh Conferences are preceded by a training session on a subject related to **Terminology and Artificial Intelligence**.

A **Young Researcher prize** has been awarded since 2011 (*all the authors of the paper must belong to this category*).
